MAXIMUM SIZE: A4 (one sided)

Maximum of 20 entries per school/child care centre/organisation permitted for Category 2

CATEGORY 3: SCULPTURE

Submit any style of 3D artwork using a variety of mediums.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 1m (h) x 1m (w) x 1m (d) Maximum of 25 entries per school/child care centre/organisation permitted for Category 3

DEFINITIONS:

A <u>medium</u> refers to the materials that are used to create a work of art, therefore whatever a piece of art is made from is its medium.

<u>Community</u> can mean different things to different people; however, it can be described as a group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common.

A <u>Word Cloud</u> is a visual representation of text data, typically used to depict keywords or to visualise a group of single words.

- <u>2D</u> Two-dimensional pieces are objects with only height and width.
- <u>3D</u> Three-dimensional pieces are objects that have height, width, and depth.
