

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entry of artwork into the exhibition is free.
2. Entry forms must be submitted by the deadline: Friday 26 April 2019.
3. Maximum of one (1) entry per child, per category.
4. Children 3 to 16 years of age are eligible to enter all exhibition categories.
5. All category entry limits must be strictly followed.
6. Each entry must be labelled on the reverse side with the child's name, age and contact details (*i.e. School or Organisation*)
7. The City of Palmerston takes no responsibility for any damage caused to artworks for the duration of the exhibition.
8. Artworks must be collected by COB Friday 14 June 2019. Any artworks not collected by this time may be disposed of.
9. Entries not adhering to the maximum size requirements will not be eligible for display in the exhibition.
10. Excluding category 5, all other categories are designed for individual participation.

EXHIBITION CATEGORIES

All exhibition categories are open to children aged 3 to 16 years. Entry forms can be submitted from schools, child care centres, parents & guardians and organisations running children's and youth programs.

CATEGORY 1: PEOPLE WHO ARE IMPORTANT TO ME

Draw or paint a picture of people in your life who are important to you. Please label the pictures or provide a short explanation.

MAXIMUM SIZE: A3 (one sided)

Maximum of 20 entries per school/child care centre/organisation permitted for Category 1

CATEGORY 2: WORDS THAT DESCRIBE ME

Write a short story, poem or create a word cloud that describes your life.

MAXIMUM SIZE: A4 (one sided)

Maximum of 20 entries per school/child care centre/organisation permitted for Category 2

CATEGORY 3: SCULPTURE

Submit any style of 3D artwork using a variety of mediums.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 1m (h) x 1m (w) x 1m (d)

Maximum of 25 entries per school/child care centre/organisation permitted for Category 3

CATEGORY 4: YOUR CHOICE

Submit any style of 2D artwork using a medium of your choice.

MAXIMUM SIZE: A3 (one sided)

Maximum of 25 entries per school/child care centre/organisation permitted for Category 4

CATEGORY 5: OUR MURAL

Create a mural as a school, class, centre or family, that describes your community using a variety of mediums. Minor assistance from adults is permitted in this category.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 1m (h) x 2m (w) x 2cm (d) OR 2m (h) x 1m (w) x 2cm (d)

Maximum of 1 entry per school/child care centre/organisation for Category 5

DEFINITIONS:

A medium refers to the materials that are used to create a work of art, therefore whatever a piece of art is made from is its medium.

Community can mean different things to different people; however, it can be described as a group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common.

A Word Cloud is a visual representation of text data, typically used to depict keywords or to visualise a group of single words.

2D - Two-dimensional pieces are objects with only height and width.

3D - Three-dimensional pieces are objects that have height, width, and depth.
