

LANEWAY TREATMENT TRIAL

FACT SHEET



Council has been progressing a laneway trial to explore treatment options that may discourage the occurrence of anti-social behaviour, whilst maintaining connection for the community.

BACKGROUND - STAGE 1

Council recognises that laneways provide access and connection for people in the community, but also understands that there have been issues with anti-social behaviour.

Council has been exploring options that may discourage the occurrence of anti-social behaviour, whilst maintaining connection for the community.

Consultation for this project is being progressed in two stages. Stage 1 was undertaken in early 2019 to gather feedback on the uses and issues associated with laneways.

LANEWAY LOCATIONS

Eleven laneways were selected for the trial treatments and are shown on the map attached.

LANEWAY TREATMENTS

The treatments that have been trialled in different laneways include:

- LED lighting upgrades - some with motion sensors
- Treatments to deter motorbikes
- Temporary night time closures

STAGE 2

Stage 2 of the consultation will run from 1 August 2019 until 22 August 2019. Your feedback will help Council evaluate the effect of these treatments and help to inform future treatments in laneways.
