The proposed upgrades will ensure that we continue to cater for the needs of our diverse local community by creating a contemporary year-round aquatic leisure centre.

Background

Upgrades to Palmerston's only public swimming pool are needed to improve the facilities, renew an aged facility and meet the needs of our growing community and region.

The proposed upgrades will include a purpose built learn to swim and wellness program pool and family-friendly activity features for all ages and abilities, as well as an adventure play zone unlike any others in the Top End.

The Northern Territory Government and City of Palmerston have already committed \$5 million for the project. City of Palmerston are having ongoing conversations with the Australian Government to secure their financial contribution for this iconic and regionally significant project.

The proposed SWELL (Swimming, Wellness, Events, Leisure, Lifestyle) master plan is part of Council's strategic vision to provide Palmerston residents with a contemporary and family friendly, water and lifestyle precinct.
