

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entry of artwork into the exhibition is free.
2. Entry forms must be submitted by the deadline: Friday 23 April 2021.
3. Maximum of one (1) entry per child, per category.
4. Maximum of 25 entries per school/child care centre/organisation for each category.
5. Please check the age eligibility of each category prior to entry. The 'All Ages' category is open to child 3 – 13 years of age.
6. All category entry limits must be strictly followed.
7. Each entry must be labelled on the reverse size with the child's name, age and school name (with the exception of Category 2).
8. City of Palmerston takes no responsibility for any damage caused to artworks for the duration of the exhibition.
9. Artworks must be collected by COB Friday 11 June 2021. Any artworks not collected by this time may be disposed of.
10. Entries not adhering to the maximum size requirements will not be eligible for display in the exhibition.

EXHIBITION CATEGORIES

Entries are open to children who live and/or attend school, care facilities or programs in Palmerston. Please check the age eligibility of each category prior to entry. The 'All Ages' category is open to children 3 – 13 years of age.

CATEGORY 1: MY FAMILY (AGES 3-5 YEARS)

Draw or paint a picture of your family and have an adult help you write a sentence that describes why family is so important.

MAXIMUM SIZE: A3 (one sided)

CATEGORY 2: DECORATIVE WISH ROCKS (AGES 6-10 YEARS)

Decorate a small natural river stone with an original design on one side and a wish for your family on the other. Once the exhibition is over, the rocks will be distributed throughout Palmerston parks for people to discover.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 5cm x 5cm per rock

CATEGORY 3: WHO AM I? (AGES 6-10 YEARS)

Create an abstract self-portrait using a variety of mixed media. Describe yourself and the things you enjoy doing when you are not at school.

MAXIMUM SIZE: A3 (one sided)

CATEGORY 4: SCULPTURE (ALL AGES)

Submit any style of 3D artwork using a variety of mediums.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 1m (h) x 1m (w) x 1m (d)

CATEGORY 5: YOUR CHOICE (ALL AGES)

Submit any style of 2D artwork using a medium of your choice.

MAXIMUM SIZE: A3 (one sided)

CATEGORY 6: PUZZLE PIECE GROUP PROJECT (ALL AGES)

Work in a group to create a puzzle that symbolises what a family friendly community would look like to you using pictures and words. Puzzle piece template provided.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 1m x 1m

DEFINITIONS

A medium refers to the materials that are used to create a work of art, therefore whatever a piece of art is made from is its medium.

2D - Two-dimensional pieces are objects with only height and width.

3D - Three-dimensional pieces are objects that have height, width, and depth.
