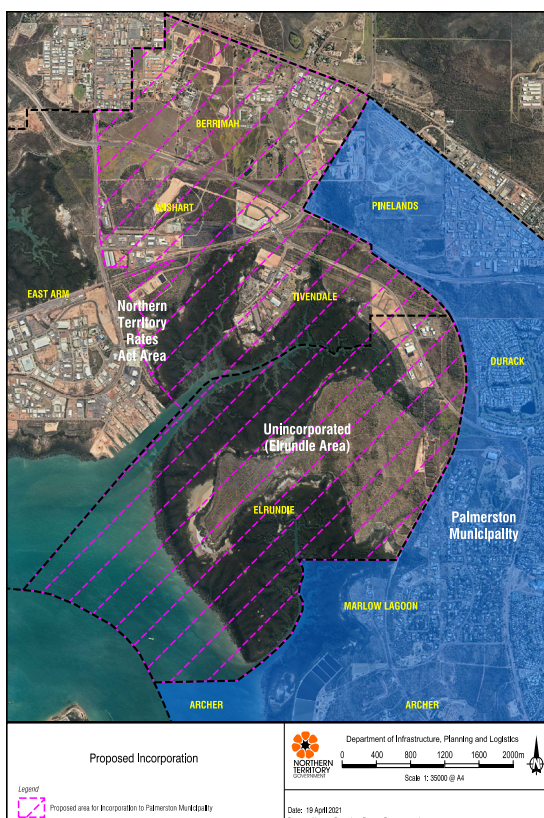
This is a great opportunity to make Palmerston bigger and more diverse and deliver more services and community events for residents over the long term.

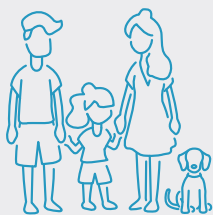
WHAT WILL CHANGE FOR ME?
