Shortlisted films will be viewed at Events Cinema on 15 July at On the Hunt @ Events Vmax Cinema.This competition has a total prize pool of \$3500 up for grabs.

PALMY SHORT FILM COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The city of palmerston shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, expense, or personal injury which may be sustained by the participant by reason of any neglect, omission, or failure on the part of any participating organisations or their employees resulting from participating in the activities of this program.
- 2. This competition is sponsored by the northern territory government and City of Palmerston.
- 3. Your film must be under 3 minutes duration, including intro and credits. No exceptions.
- 4. You must be aged between 10-17 years to be eligible.
- 5. Films are to creatively include "rise." It can be as literal or abstract as you like!
- 6. If you are using another person's music in your film, please make sure you have their permission to do so. If you do not have an artists' permission or have not made your own music or sourced copyright free material, your film will not be eligible for the competition.

- 7. Palmy short film comp is open to filmmakers from the Northern Territory residents.
- 8. Creativity, originality, and storytelling will be more highly considered in judging than production value you don't need a flashy camera to make a great, captivating short film. It's your story and how you tell it that counts.
- 9. You can enter as many films as you like, provided you meet the entry criteria.
- 10. Your film is to be rated G or PG. This means no violence, drugs, swearing or sexual content. If your film cannot be shown at a public screening for families then your film may not be eligible. City of palmerston reserves the right to not include any films that contradict this rule. If in doubt, ask us by calling 8935 9967.
- 11. All key roles (e.g., director, producer, writer, cinematographer, editor, actor) must be aged between 10-17 to be eligible. Friends and family can help you make your film, but the main roles need to be done by a young person.
- 12. For your film to be eligible you will need to officially enter it by filling out the entry form and by submitting your film before friday 2 July 2021, 5pm.
- 13. Films must be in english or have english subtitles.
- 14. In order to be considered, you must provide a downloadable HD video file in NTSC format.
- 15. By submitting your film, you are agreeing to the following:
 You give permission for your film to be a part of the palmerston youth festival "short film comp" to be played at the on the hunt @events at event cinema.
 - You give permission for your film to be hosted on city of palmerston (via YouTube as a secondary host) if it is shortlisted.
- 16. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 17. The promoter's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered.

Prize component

- 1. Employees of City of Palmerston or their family members or anyone else connected in any way with the competition or helping to set up the competition shall not be permitted to enter the competition
- 2. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
- 3. The promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter's control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the promoter.
- 4. Winner will be notified at the final festival event on the 16th of July and discussions surrounding the booking of the prize will be entered into in the week following the event.
- 5. No cash or alternative prizes will be offered.
- 6. The judging panel will the shortlisted films to be voted on by the community.
- 7. The winner agrees to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material.
