Who can enter?

Anyone that,

- 1. is super passionate about becoming a chef or baker.
- 2. lives in Palmerston, Darwin or Rural that can get to the Palmerston CDU Campus.
- 3. is aged 16 to 24 that is not currently enrolled in school or any other university course.

How can I enter?

- 2. Attend the 3 hour Masterclass and complete the cooking/baking challenge.
- 3. If you are shortlisted you will be called back for an interview.
- 4. Two people will be selected from the interview panel.

ROOKIE COOKS COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The City of Palmerston shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, expense or personal injury which may be sustained by the participant by reason of any neglect, omission, or failure on the part of any participating organisations or their employees resulting from participating in the activities of this program.
- 2. This competition is sponsored by the Northern Territory Government and City of Palmerston.
- 3. To apply you must be passionate about cooking or baking and want to win one of the scholarships.
- 4. You must be aged 16 to 24 years of age
- 5. All entries will be considered, but only the chosen top 32 (16 in each masterclass) will participate in the competition.
- 6. You must complete all sections of this form to be considered in the competition.
- 7. You must not be enrolled in school or any other university course.
- 8. You must live in Darwin, Palmerston or Rural areas and be able to get to Palmerston campus for the course, should you win.
- 9. You must attend the 3 hour masterclass that you apply to attend.
- 10. You can apply for both cooking and baking, if there is a high number of applications you may have to choose one session as your preference.
- 11. Each participant will receive a score for their creation during the Masterclass. Top three competitors of each session will be shortlisted and called back for an interview.
- 12. The interview panel will take place on Thursday 15 July between 8am to 5pm.
- The interview panel will choose two lucky people to win a scholarship: CDU will offer a maximum of two (2) scholarships in either of the two following qualifications:
 - SIT30816 Certificate III in Commercial Cookery
 - FBP30517 Certificate III in Baking
 - City of Palmerston will supply the uniform and tools.
 - (Total prize value per winner upto \$4400.00)
- 14. If no participant meets the guidelines, CDU reserves the right to withhold awarding 1 or more scholarships.
- 15. Applications close 5pm 3 July 2021. No applications will be accepted after this date.
- 16. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 17. The promoter's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.



ROOKIE COOKS COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTINUED

Prize component

- 1. Employees of City of Palmerston or their family members or anyone else connected in any way with the competition or helping to set up the competition shall not be permitted to enter the competition.
- 2. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
- 3. The promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter's control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the promoter.
- 4. Winner will be notified at the final festival event on the 16th July and discussions surrounding the booking of the prize will be entered into in the week following the event.
- 5. No cash or alternative prizes will offered.
- 6. The judging panel will choose the Rookie Cooks Champion 2021 and this decision will be final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 7. The winner agrees to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material.
