SWELL DAYS AHEAD IN PALMERSTON

City of Palmerston's SWELL is getting closer!



The Swimming, Wellness, Events, Leisure and Lifestyle (SWELL) precinct is City of Palmerston's largest infrastructure project to date and is transforming your local pool into a wellness and leisure hub with something for everyone.

Construction is well underway, and the project team continues to meet key construction milestones. The important underground work which will ensure SWELL runs smoothly is now complete and the new Myrtha lining all the way from Italy is installed in the 50m and program pools. This new technology will ensure the SWELL pool is fit-for-purpose for many sunny Territory days to come.

In the coming months you can expect to see big changes at the SWELL site with pool furniture such as ramps and stairs being installed at the 50-metre lap pool, shade structure going up, footings for the adventure play and the completion of the half basketball court.

GYM

The SWELL Gym will temporarily close its doors to the public in late September for some well deserved upgrades. Included in the improvements to this facility is re-roofing, which is expected to take place in October/ November.

The SWELL Gym will open again alongside the SWELL pool later this year. Keep an eye on the Council website and social media for more information.

ABOUT CONSTRUCTION

SWELL construction began in August 2022 and is currently on track, with the new facility expected to open in late 2023.

City of Palmerston is working with contractor Jaytex Construction to ensure the impacts of the project to surrounding residents, schools and businesses are managed. Measures are in place to minimise the impacts caused by construction, including the timing of works, traffic management, waste management, and noise and safety measures.

Those impacted by disruptive works or night works will receive advance notice and City of Palmerston will work with stakeholders to ensure business operations can continue throughout construction.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The new SWELL facility is an exciting addition to the Palmerston community! The upgraded facility will include a 20m warm water pool for learn to swim and wellness classes, a refurbished 50m pool for swim fanatics, a new and improved zero-depth splash and play space for the little ones, and an adventure play zone unlike any other in the Top End.

The new complex will be an important asset for the community, and the redevelopment will offer a range of activities for the whole family.

As part of City of Palmerston's commitment to being a place for people, SWELL will be open and FREE* until 2026.

The project is funded by the Australian Government, with \$5 million secured through the Building Better Regions Fund, as well as the Northern Territory Government contributing \$7.5 million and City of Palmerston contributing \$6.9 million.
