FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What is Reboot Your Loot?

Reboot Your Loot is the City of Palmerston's community car boot sale. It allows residents to sell unwanted household items, second-hand goods, and bric-a-brac from the boot of their cars.

This event is hosted prior to the Pre-Cyclone clean up.

How do I register for a stall?

All stallholders must register for free via City of Palmerston Website <u>HERE</u>

Once registered, you'll receive setup instructions and a site map by email.

Is there a cost to have a stall?

No. Registration and participation are completely free.

What can I sell at my stall?

You can sell:

- Household items
- Clothes
- Toys
- Books
- Plants

What can't I sell?

Please do not sell:

- Animals
- Automotive parts/ accessories
- Food or beverages
- Illegal or counterfeit items
- Large appliances or hazardous materials
- Protective or safety equipment
- Weapons, knives, or dangerous goods
- Electrical items

Unsuitable items may result in stallholder removal.

What time should I arrive to set up?

Stallholder setup begins from 6:30am. Please allow time to check in and setup. All vehicles must be in place by 7:45am.

Are we required to have Public Liability Insurance?

While stallholders are encouraged to hold Public Liability Insurance, it is not a mandatory requirement.

All stallholders must read the event terms and conditions and agree; to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Palmerston, its employees, officers and agents from and against any and all claims, demands, losses, damages, costs, and expenses (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis) arising out of or in connection with the sale or offering for sale of any items that are excluded under the Stallholder's insurance policy during the Reboot Your Loot event. This indemnity applies regardless of any negligence or omission on the part of the City of Palmerston, except to the extent that such claim, demand, loss or damage is caused by the City of Palmerston's gross negligence or wilful misconduct.

Will there be parking for visitors?

Yes. Public parking will be available nearby. Stallholders will park in designated spaces for selling. Please reference the map above.

Is there anything I need to bring?

You should bring:

- Your own table (optional)
- Shade and water (e.g., umbrella or small marquee no pegs allowed)
- Cash/change for transactions
- Reusable bags (optional for customers)
