
## **VERGE MAINTENANCE REBATE**



## Terms of entry

Eligibility for Entry	Entry to the Rebate is open to all City of Palmerston residents that satisfy the Terms and Conditions.
Details of Rebate.	One (1) application will be accepted per household or residence per year to a maximum value of \$50 (including GST).
Terms of Entry	<ul> <li>Agree to the terms and conditions of the Rebate initiative. (Published on City of Palmerston Website).</li> <li>All entrants shall be 18 years old or older.</li> <li>The Verge Maintenance Rebate applies to City of Palmerston residents who have undertaken lawn care for their verge on or after 1 July 2025. Lawn care may comprise engagement of professional mowing services, application of fertiliser and/or growth enhancers, and any other services and products that can be reasonably attributed to the maintenance of lawns on verges.</li> <li>Only one rebate can be claimed for each City of Palmerston residence per financial year. The rebate is linked to the address not individual residents.</li> <li>The verge maintenance budget will be allocated on a first comes first served basis until the budget is expended.</li> <li>The Verge Maintenance Rebate only applies to purchases made with Northern Territory based businesses.</li> <li>The rebate is for eligible purchases to a maximum value to \$50 (including GST). For example, if the purchase cost is less than \$50 (including GST) then the rebate will be for the purchase price only</li> <li>To make a claim, the following information is required: <ul> <li>A copy of the tax invoice receipt clearly showing the item description, purchase date, price and place of purchase.</li> <li>Proof of residence (e.g. copy of rates notice, driver's license or utility bill showing applicants name and residential address).</li> <li>Photograph of completed lawn area.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>



	<ul> <li>Application for the rebate must be made no more than 3 months from the date of purchase (As per the Tax Invoice).</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Payments are made by EFT. Payments may take up to four weeks to be processed from the date the application is received by council.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>City of Palmerston reserve the right to modify these terms and conditions at any time.</li> </ul>
Maximum Entries	One entry per address per financial year.

## **Terms & Conditions**

- 1. The Terms and Conditions are made up of the Terms of entry (Schedule) and these Terms & Conditions.
- 2. Participation in this Rebate initiative is deemed acceptance of these Terms of Entry. Entrants not complying with these Terms of entry are ineligible entrants and City of Palmerston reserves its absolute right to disqualify any entrant from the Rebate initiative if any entries do not comply with the Terms and Conditions.
- 3. Entry is open to any person who meets the requirements of these Terms and Conditions.
- 4. The Rebate initiative will be conducted during the Rebate initiative period as stated within the Rebate initiative period details of the Terms of Entry
- 5. The Payments are specified in the Details of Payment section of the Terms of Entry.
- 6. Any payment is valued in Australian dollars unless expressly stated to the contrary.
- 7. Entrants are advised that tax implications may arise from their payment, and they should seek independent financial advice prior to acceptance of their payment. City of Palmerston accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from accepting a payment. Entrants are responsible for any and all expenses that they incur in entering the Rebate initiative.
- 8. The time of entry will be deemed to be the time the entry is received by City of Palmerston.
- 9. Entrants may submit up to the Maximum number of entries as stated in the Terms of entry.
- 10. City of Palmerston accepts no responsibility for any late, lost, delayed, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, corrupted, illegible, or misdirected entries, claims or correspondence whether due to omission, error, alteration, tampering, deletion, theft, destruction, disruption to any communication network or medium, or otherwise including those entries not received by City of Palmerston for any reason. City of Palmerston is not liable for any consequences of user error including (without limitation) costs incurred. No correspondence will be entered into.

- 11. City of Palmerston takes no responsibility where it is unable to contact rebate recipients who have not provided correct or complete contact details. If a recipient contact details change during the Rebate initiative period, it is the entrant's responsibility to notify City of Palmerston. A request to modify any entry information should be directed to City of Palmerston.
- 12. Entrants acknowledge that there may be risks to personal property and personal safety that may result in loss, injury or death when participating in the Rebate initiative. - 16. City of Palmerston and its associated agencies and companies will not be liable for any delay, damage, or loss in transit of payments.
- 17. City of Palmerston may in its absolute discretion not accept a particular entry, may disqualify an entry, or cancel the entire Rebate initiative at any time without giving reasons and without liability to any entrants, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority. Without limiting this City of Palmerston reserves the right to verify the validity of entries, payments and entrants and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is misleading or not in accordance with these Terms of entry or who manipulates or tampers with the entry process. In the event that a applicant breaches these Terms of entry, they will forfeit the payment in whole and no substitute will be offered. Verification is at the discretion of City of Palmerston, whose decision is final. Failure by City of Palmerston to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

In the case of the intervention of any outside act, agent or event which prevents or significantly hinders City of Palmerston's ability (or that of a third party involved with the Rebate Program) to proceed with the Rebate initiative on the dates and in the manner described in these Terms of entry, including but not limited to vandalism, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strike, war, act of terrorism, City of Palmerston's obligations in respect of the Rebate initiative will be suspended for the duration of the event and, in addition, City of Palmerston may in its absolute discretion cancel the Rebate initiative and recommence it from the start on the same conditions, subject to approval of the relevant authorities.
