

# ALCOHOL MANAGEMENT PLAN

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| <b>Strategy 1</b>   | <b>Action</b>   |
| Integrity in regard to Alcohol policy in Palmerston.                            | Cease any holder of an NT Liquor Licence in the Northern Territory from donating cash or in-kind support to any Political Party.  |
| <b>Strategy 2</b>   | <b>Action</b>   |
| A reduction in takeaway alcohol in Palmerston for a period of 18 months.        | Adjust the hours that takeaway alcohol is sold in the Municipality, from the current 9am – 10pm to 11am – 8pm. 13 hours down to 9 hours. (Harm minimisation strategy)   |
| <b>Strategy 3</b>   | <b>Action</b>   |
| Reduce current number of liquor licences in the municipality.                   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Extend the takeaway alcohol licence buy-back EOIs to all active takeaway licences, providing all licensee's an opportunity to sell their active licenses back in a jointly funded program by the City of Palmerston Council and the Northern Territory Government. City of Palmerston's contribution would be a capped fixed amount.</li><li>• Extend the moratorium on not issuing any new takeaway licences in Palmerston.</li><li>• Prohibit the transfer of takeaway licenses from outside of the Palmerston LGA into Palmerston.</li><li>• Abandoned Licences be enforced and not allowed to continue.</li></ul> |
| <b>Strategy 4</b>   | <b>Action</b>   |
| Educational programs for youth focussing on a better relationship with alcohol. | TV, Radio, social media, school program and workshops focussed on cultural change not legislative changes.  |
| <b>Strategy 5</b>   | <b>Action</b>   |
| Support and Rehabilitation Services   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• That a gap analysis be undertaken to determine the current support, rehabilitation services and domestic violence support services available in Palmerston versus the need.</li><li>• That an action plan be developed based on the analysis.</li></ul>   |
