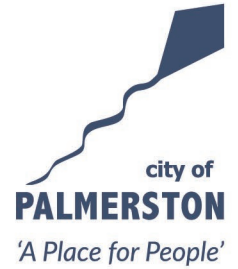

## VOUCHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Program Offer	\$50 voucher towards desexing of one cat or dog
Application Requirement	Applications must be submitted via the City of Palmerston website: <a href="https://palmerston.nt.gov.au/desexing-program">https://palmerston.nt.gov.au/desexing-program</a>
Limit per Applicant	One voucher per applicant, unless otherwise approved by City of Palmerston
Assessment Criteria	Applications will be assessed by City of Palmerston: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Eligibility requirements including financial hardship;</li><li>• priority criteria determined by City of Palmerston (such as unregistered animals, concession card holders or animal welfare concerns); and</li><li>• the number of applications received.</li></ul>
Participating Clinics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• University Avenue Vets The ARK Animal Hospital</li></ul>
Voucher Conditions	Valid for desexing services only and must be used at participating clinics
Availability	Limited number of vouchers available



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The applicant must be a resident of City of Palmerston and provide proof of residency.
2. Vouchers are available for domestic cats and dogs only.
3. Only one voucher per applicant applies, unless otherwise approved by City of Palmerston.
4. Applications will be assessed by City of Palmerston:
  - Eligibility requirements including financial hardship;
  - priority criteria determined by City of Palmerston (such as unregistered animals, concession card holders or animal welfare concerns); and
  - the number of applications received.
5. Submission of an application does not guarantee approval or issue of a voucher.
6. Successful applicants will be notified by City of Palmerston and provided with details on how to redeem the voucher.
7. The voucher must be used at a participating veterinary clinic approved by City of Palmerston.
8. The voucher is non-transferable, has no cash value, and cannot be exchanged for other services.
9. Any costs above the voucher amount, including additional treatments, medications or complications are the responsibility of the pet owner.
10. The animal owner is responsible for arranging and attending all veterinary appointments.
11. Council does not guarantee the availability of appointments at participating veterinary clinics.
12. The applicant acknowledges that de-sexing is a veterinary procedure and accepts all associated risks. City of Palmerston accepts no liability for any injury, illness, complications, or death arising from the procedure.
13. False or misleading information provided in the application may result in the voucher being cancelled or refused.
14. Council reserves the right to amend, suspend or discontinue the program at any time.
15. By submitting this application, the applicant agrees to these Terms and Conditions and consents to City of Palmerston using the information provided for administration of the program.
