

The services for single dwelling and multiple dwellings with less than four (4) units are:

- a kerbside collection service of two (2) general waste collection visits per week with a maximum of one 120 litre mobile bin; or
- a kerbside collection service of two (2) general waste collection visits per week with a maximum of one 240 litre mobile bin; and
- a kerbside recycling collection service of one (1) visit per fortnight with a maximum of one 240 litre mobile bin per recycling collection service.

The services for multiple dwellings with four or more units are:

- Manual collection service of four (4) general waste collection visits per week.
- Manual collection service of one (1) recycle collection visit per week.

The following services apply to all residential dwellings:

- one pre-cyclone season bulk goods collection visit;
- access to and maintenance of a waste disposal facility;
- public place bin collections and street sweeping.

This is a set charge for the full service which is not able to be split to suit individual residents.

* Where a property has more than twenty-five (25) units, the property is entitled to make their own waste collection service arrangements. To receive a reduction in the annual waste levy fee the body corporate/owners will need to demonstrate to Council that the waste collection service arrangement complies with Council's [Waste Management Guideline](#).
