SWELL construction is set to begin

City of Palmerston is excited to announce the construction tender for the SWELL precinct has been awarded to Jaytex Construction at the value of \$19.4 million.

Palmerston's largest infrastructure project to date, SWELL (Swimming, Wellness, Events, Leisure and Lifestyle), is set to transform the current aging Palmerston Swimming and Fitness Centre into a leisure hub. Council acknowledges the importance that the hub holds to the community, as it sets to cater for a wider demographic of varied interests for a growing population.

The SWELL project will include the refurbishment of the 50-metre pool, a toddlers zero depth and play pool, an events area, basketball half court, new and improved accessible toilets and change rooms and aquatic play structure.

City of Palmerston Mayor, Athina Pascoe-Bell says a significant milestone has been reached with the construction tender successfully awarded.

"It is with great anticipation that we announce the successful tender bid for the SWELL construction to Jaytex Construction. This is Council's largest project to date, and we are thrilled to be getting closer to the construction. We have a great relationship with the Territory and Australian Governments and without their support we couldn't bring such a fantastic facility to the people of Palmerston."

This project is funded by the Australian Government, with \$5 million secured through the Building Better Regions Fund, as well as the Northern Territory Government contributing \$7.5 million, and City of Palmerston \$6.9 million.

Early stages of construction are planned to commence August 2022, with anticipated completion towards the end of 2023.
