




Dear Mr Rosse.

Between the end of Sextant court and Harrison Circuit is a lane way that I propose be permanently closed or have a night time closure placed on it. I also suggest more lighting in the park area across the road or the existing lights to be upgraded to a brighter light source.

I do believe this is a problematic laneway as it is a through fair for criminals in our area. All residences have dogs to protect our properties. Although no residences have yet experienced break ins (that I'm aware of), I think this would be a great preventative measure for the future. My fence is on this lane way and as you may see it constantly has holes poked in it, and sheeting ripped off. The smell of human faeces and urine is also present, this is right near where my son Plays and guests gather in my back yard.
